The Promoter

The promoter is: Alastair LLP of 1 Soho Place, London, W1D 3BG

The competition

- 2.1 The title of the competition is 'Griddles'.
- 2.2 There will be 12 riddles in total. The riddles will be organised into three series with four riddles per series.

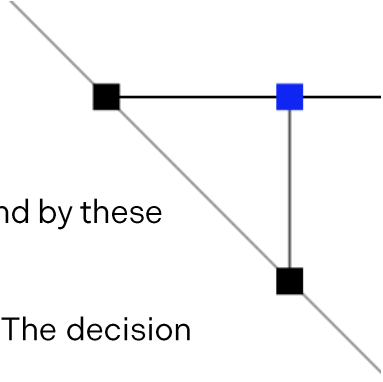

Each riddle will have a 28-day deadline. The website will indicate the closing date for each riddle, which riddles are still live and which are closed.

Solutions will be shared separately for each riddle via a mailing list, a couple of days after the deadline for each riddle.

How to enter

- 3.1 The competition will run from each riddle launch date for 28 days.
- 3.2 All competition entries must be received by the Promoter on the G-Research webpage [<https://www.gresearch.com/griddles/>] by no later than midnight UK time on the closing date for each riddle. All competition entries received after the respective closing date will be automatically disqualified.
- 3.3 To enter the competition:
 - (a) enter the competition online by filling out the entry form on the G-Research webpage [<https://www.gresearch.com/griddles/>].
- 3.4 No purchase necessary and there is no charge to register.
- 3.5 The Promoter will **not** accept:
 - (a) responsibility for competition entries that are corrupted, not successfully completed or transmitted, lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any postal failure, equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, website, computer hardware or software failure of any kind; or
 - (b) proof of transmission as proof of receipt of entry to the competition.

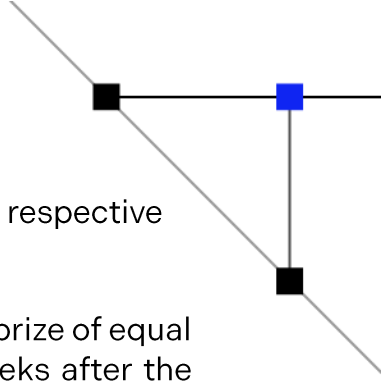

- 3.6 By submitting a competition entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 3.7 The competition entries will be marked by a panel of judges. The decision of the panel of judges (acting reasonably) will be final.

Eligibility

- 4.1 The competition is only open to citizens of the UK, an EEA member country, Switzerland, Canada and the USA, who are 18 years or over, **except:**
- (a) employees of the Promoter or its holding or subsidiary companies;
 - (b) employees of agents or suppliers of the Promoter or its holding or subsidiary companies, who are professionally connected with the competition or its administration; or
 - (c) members of the immediate families or households of (a) and (b) above.
- 4.2 In entering the competition, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win. The Promoter may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the competition.
- 4.3 The Promoter will not accept competition entries that are:
- (a) automatically generated by computer or created by artificial intelligence (including but not limited to chatbots such as ChatGPT or similar software applications);
 - (b) completed by third parties or in bulk;
 - (c) illegible, have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with; or
 - (d) incomplete.
- 4.4 There is a limit of one entry to the competition per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.
- 4.5 The Promoter reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize competition.

The prize

- 5.1 There are 15 prizes overall to be won. There is a £1,000 (one thousand pounds GBP) prize for each riddle. Winners for each riddle shall be drawn at random from correct eligible entries. There is also an additional prize of £2,000 (two thousand pounds GBP) for riddles number 4, 8 and 12 for the



first correct answer received for each of those riddles by the respective closing date.

- 5.2 The Promoter reserves the right to substitute the prize with a prize of equal or greater value. Draw to select winners will take place 2 weeks after the competition has closed.
- 5.3 The prize is not negotiable or transferable.
- 5.4 In order to claim the prize you must follow instructions as provided by the promoter

Winners

- 6.1 The decision of the Promoter is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 6.2 The Promoter will contact the winners by email as soon as practicable after they have been selected. The Promoter will not amend any contact information once the competition entry has been submitted.
- 6.3 Promoter will publish the name of the prize winners on the GR website.
- 6.4 If you object to your name being published or made available, please contact the Promoter at griddles@gresearch.com. In such circumstances, the Promoter may still provide the information and winning entry to a regulator if requested.

Claiming the prize

- 7.1 If you are the winner of a prize, you will have 14 days from being contacted to claim the prize by answering the promoter's email. If you do not claim the prize by this date, your claim will become invalid.
- 7.2 The prize may not be claimed by a third party on your behalf.
- 7.3 The Promoter will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If a winner has not claimed their prize within 14 days of being informed that they have won a prize, the Promoter reserves the right to conduct a re-draw of the prize or offer the prize to the next eligible entrant (second fastest correct solution received for riddles 4, 8 and 12).
- 7.4 The Promoter does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up a prize.

Limitation of liability

Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees.

Ownership of competition entries and intellectual property rights

- 9.1 The Promoter does not claim any rights of ownership in your competition entry.
- 9.2 You agree that the Promoter may, in their sole discretion, make your entry available on its website (<https://www.gresearch.com/>) and in any other media, whether now known or invented in the future, and in connection with any publicity of the competition. You grant the Promoter a non-exclusive, worldwide, irrevocable licence in perpetuity, for the full period of the intellectual property rights in the competition entry and any accompanying materials, to use, display, publish, transmit, copy, edit, alter, store, re-format and sub-licence the intellectual property rights in the competition entry and any accompanying materials for such purposes.

Data protection and publicity

- 10.1 The Promoter will only process your personal information as set out in the privacy policy (<https://www.gresearch.com/privacy-policy/>).

General

- 11.1 If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, the Promoter may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the competition.
- 11.2 The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the prize competition where it becomes necessary to do so.
- 11.3 These terms and conditions are governed by English law. If any entrants to this promotion wish to take court proceedings, then they must do this within the courts in the United Kingdom.
